1       **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2             **Sec. 1. 29-A MRS §2395, sub-§9** is enacted to read:

3             **9. Exemption.** A commercial motor vehicle hauling a perishable product is exempt  
4 from this section.

5   **SUMMARY**

6             This bill exempts commercial motor vehicles hauling perishable products from the  
7 restrictions on ways requiring special protection by the Department of Transportation,  
8 counties or municipalities.
