COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 122, L.D. 381, Bill, "An Act To Allow Delivery Vehicles To Display Lighted Advertising Signs"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Allow Food Delivery Vehicles To Display an Illuminated Sign'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1922, sub-§4, ¶¶B and C, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, are amended to read:

B. On a semitrailer, on the front portion of the semitrailer; ~~and~~

C. On a truck, on the front portion of the storage compartment above and behind the cab; ~~and~~

Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1922, sub-§4, ¶D is enacted to read:

D. On the roof of a privately owned automobile used for home delivery of commercially prepared food. An illuminated sign on an automobile under this paragraph:

(1) Must emit a white light;

(2) May not use primarily green, red or blue colors;

(3) May not have more than 4 sides and may not exceed 18 inches in height, 24 inches in length and 15 inches in width; and

(4) May be illuminated only at nighttime and during a delivery.'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, replaces the bill and changes the title. The amendment allows a privately owned automobile used for home
