2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2422, sub-§2, ¶D**, as amended by PL 2013, c. 361, §1, is  
3 further amended to read:

4 D. Any other medical condition or its treatment as provided for in section 2424,  
5 subsection 2; ~~or~~

6 **Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2422, sub-§2, ¶E**, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 361, §1, is  
7 amended to read:

8 E. Post-traumatic stress disorder, inflammatory bowel disease, dyskinetic and spastic  
9 movement disorders and other diseases causing severe and persistent muscle spasms;  
10 or

11 **Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §2422, sub-§2, ¶F** is enacted to read:

12 F. Addiction to or dependency on opiates or prescription drugs.

14 This bill adds addiction to or dependency on opiates or prescription drugs to the list  
15 of qualifying conditions for medical marijuana.
