## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill requires the Bureau of Insurance to convene a stakeholders group to identify the best practices for evidencebased alternative therapy for the treatment of opioid and heroin addiction. The bureau has indicated it has no expertise in this area and would most likely hire a qualified consultant. No estimate of the cost involved is made at this time.
