13 14	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:
15	'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4801, sub-§2-B is enacted to read:
16 17	2-B. Start time. A school administrative unit may provide that a secondary school in the unit does not start a school day before 8:30 a.m.'
18	SUMMARY
19 20 21	This amendment is the majority report of the committee and provides that a school administrative unit may provide that its secondary schools' school days start no earlier than 8:30 a.m. The bill makes the later start time a requirement.
