COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 331, L.D. 468, Bill, "An Act To Provide for a Later Starting Time for High Schools"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act Regarding Later Starting Time for High Schools'**

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4801, sub-§2-B is enacted to read:**

**2-B. Start time. A school administrative unit may provide that a secondary school in the unit does not start a school day before 8:30 a.m.'**

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the majority report of the committee and provides that a school administrative unit may provide that its secondary schools' school days start no earlier than 8:30 a.m. The bill makes the later start time a requirement.
