1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12454, sub-§2** is enacted to read:

3 **2. Ice fishing in Seboomook Lake Township.** Notwithstanding subsection 1, Baker
4 Lake in Township 7, Range 17 WELS; Third St. John Pond in Township 4, Range 17
5 WELS and Township 5, Range 17 WELS; Fourth St. John Pond in Township 5, Range 17
6 WELS; and Fifth St. John Pond in Township 5, Range 17 WELS and Township 6, Range
7 17 WELS, all in Somerset County, are open to ice fishing.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill allows ice fishing on Baker Lake and Third, Fourth and Fifth St. John ponds
10 in Somerset County.
