4 5 6	B. Sell, display, raffle, give away or offer for sale to the public any live fowl, turtles or rabbits under 8 weeks of age in lots of less than 6 for the period beginning 6 weeks before Easter Sunday and ending 6 weeks after Easter Sunday;
7	SUMMARY
8	Current law prohibits a person from selling, displaying, raffling, giving away or
9	offering for sale to the public any live fowl, turtles or rabbits under 8 weeks of age in lots
10	of less than 6. This bill limits that prohibition to the period beginning 6 weeks before
11	Easter Sunday and ending 6 weeks after Easter Sunday.
