1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §7015** is enacted to read:

3 **§7015. Crew size; freight train**

4 A railroad company or railroad authority shall ensure that there are at least 2
5 employees on a freight train traveling on a railroad line within the State, except for a
6 freight train traveling for hostler service. A railroad company or railroad authority that
7 violates this section is subject to a fine of not more than \$500 for every violation of this
8 section.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill requires a railroad company or railroad authority to ensure that there are at
11 least 2 employees on a freight train traveling on a railroad line within the State, except for
12 a freight train traveling for hostler service, and includes a penalty provision.
