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### **An Act Regarding Transfers of Liquor between Licensed Manufacturers' Facilities**

1           **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2           **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355-A, sub-§2, ¶K** is enacted to read:

3           K. A licensee with multiple facilities licensed for the manufacture of liquor under  
4           this section may transfer product produced by the licensee from one of those facilities  
5           to another for the purposes of selling liquor for off-premises or on-premises  
6           consumption as permitted by laws administered by the United States Department of  
7           the Treasury, Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau, including any  
8           requirements to maintain records regarding transfers between facilities.

9   **SUMMARY**

10           This bill permits a manufacturer who manufactures liquor at multiple licensed  
11           locations to transport the manufacturer's own product between those locations, as is  
12           allowed under federal law.
