Collection of social security number. If a school administrative unit, a public 15 school within a school administrative unit or a private school requests a student's social 16 security number, the unit or school shall inform the parent or legal guardian of that 17 18 student or the student if the student is 18 years of age or older for what purpose the social security number will be used and provide the parent, legal guardian or student if the 19 20 student is 18 years of age or older the opportunity to opt out of providing the social 21 security number. 22 2. Deletion of social security number. A school administrative unit, a public 23 school within a school administrative unit or a private school that collects a student's 24 social security number shall delete the student's social security number from the student's 25 records once the student is no longer enrolled in the school administrative unit, the public 26 school within a school administrative unit or private school." 27 SUMMARY 28 This amendment replaces the bill and places provisions regarding student social 29 security numbers in the part of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A that deals with 30 student records. The amendment requires a school administrative unit, a public school 31 within a school administrative unit or a private school, if asking for a student's social 32 security number, to inform the student's parent or legal guardian or the student if the 33 student is 18 years of age or older for what purpose the social security number will be 34 used. The amendment requires the unit or school to provide the parent, legal guardian or 35 student with the opportunity to opt out of providing the social security number.
