1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 7-A MRSA §101, sub-§2-B** is enacted to read:

3 **2-B. Local food system.** "Local food system" means a community food system
4 within a municipality that integrates food production, processing, consumption, direct
5 producer-to-consumer exchanges and other traditional foodways to enhance the
6 environmental, economic, social and nutritional health and well-being of the municipality
7 and its residents.

8 **Sec. 2. 7-A MRSA §201-B** is enacted to read:

9 **§201-B. Local authority to regulate water and food systems**

10 Pursuant to the home rule authority granted to municipalities by Title 30-A, section
11 3001 and by the Constitution of Maine, Article VIII, Part Second, and pursuant to section
12 201-A, and notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a municipal
13 government may regulate by ordinance local food systems and the transport of water for
14 commercial purposes beyond the boundaries of the municipality, and the State shall
15 recognize such ordinances.

16 **SUMMARY**

17 This bill authorizes municipal governments to regulate local food systems and the
18 transport of water for commercial purposes by ordinance and requires the State to
19 recognize such ordinances.
