COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 524, L.D. 744, Bill, "An Act To Create a Permanent Wabanaki Law Enforcement Seat on the Maine Criminal Justice Academy Board of Trustees"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2802 in the last paragraph in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "except that the Wabanaki law enforcement member serves for a term of 2 years"

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The amendment strikes from the bill the provision that limits to 2 years the term of the representative of the Wabanaki tribal governments.
