SENATE AMENDMENT " D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 525, L.D. 745

- 1. Distribution of educational materials regarding the health risks and emotional trauma inflicted by and relating to the practice of female genital mutilation;
- 2. Distribution of educational materials relating to the federal prohibition on and penalties for female genital mutilation of a minor under 18 United States Code, Section 116, penalties for female genital mutilation of a minor that may be assessed in the State under the Maine Criminal Code and mandatory reporting requirements relating to female genital mutilation of a minor pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 4011-A, subsection 1; and
- 3. Outreach and provision of culturally specific support services to victims of female genital mutilation in the State.''

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill, as amended by Committee Amendment "A," to remove language that makes it a crime for a parent, guardian or person who has immediate custody of a female person under 18 years of age to consent to or permit female genital mutilation of that female person for nonmedical purposes or for a person to remove the female person from the State for such a procedure. This amendment also incorporates language from Senate Amendment "C" to Committee Amendment "A," which directs the Department of Health and Human Services, within its existing resources, to administer education and outreach to communities in the State in which the procedure might be practiced.
