1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and  
3 allocations are made.

4 **HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION, MAINE**

5 **Historic Preservation Commission 0036**

6 Initiative: Provides a total of \$500,000 over 4 years to assist the Curran Homestead  
7 Village and Willowbrook Village museums in consolidating historical collections. The  
8 grant must be matched by local funds.

16 years in matching funds to the Maine Historic Preservation Commission for the  
17 consolidation of the historical collections of the Curran Homestead Village and  
18 Willowbrook Village museums.
