8 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 536,
9 L.D. 756, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Authority of an Affiliate of a Utility To Own
10 Power Generation outside of the Utility's Territory"

11 Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 11 by inserting after the first
12 blocked paragraph a new blocked paragraph to read:

13 'Any affiliate generation or generation-related assets permitted under this subsection that
14 do not have a commission-approved long-term contract or term sheet under this Title as
15 of July 1, 2017 are ineligible to participate in a long-term contract under this Title.'

16 SUMMARY

17 This amendment provides that any affiliate generation or generation-related assets
18 that are permitted under the bill but do not have a long-term contract or term sheet
19 approved by the Public Utilities Commission as of July 1, 2017 are ineligible to
20 participate in a long-term contract under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A.
