Required reimbursement. The department shall provide reimbursement for a 18 hearing aid for one hearing-impaired ear of an individual enrolled in the MaineCare 19 program in accordance with the following requirements: 20 The hearing loss must be documented by a primary care provider or an 21 audiologist licensed pursuant to Title 32, chapter 137; 22 The hearing aid must be provided by an audiologist or a hearing aid dealer licensed pursuant to Title 32, chapter 137; and 23 24 C. The hearing loss must meet the requirements established by the department in rule 25 regarding the individual's severity of hearing loss. The department shall provide reimbursement for a hearing aid for the 2nd hearing-26 27 impaired ear of an individual enrolled in the MaineCare program if the individual meets 28 requirements established by the department by rule regarding the individual's severity of 29 hearing loss, enrollment in school, enrollment in vocational training, employment needs 30 or the needs identified by a primary care provider. 31 **SUMMARY** 32 This amendment makes changes to the bill to match current practice in the rules of 33 the Department of Health and Human Services. It specifies that one hearing aid is 34 reimbursable under the MaineCare program and that a 2nd hearing aid is reimbursable if
