## An Act To Clarify Insurance Coverage in School-based Health Centers

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §4316-A is enacted to read:
3 4	<u>§4316-A.</u> Coverage of services provided by federally qualified health center in <u>schools</u>
5 6	<b><u>1. Definitions.</u></b> As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
7 8 9	A. "Federally qualified health center" means a center that provides preventive primary health care services and is receiving a grant under Section 330 of the federal Public Health Service Act, 42 United States Code, Section 254b.
10 11	B. "School-based health center" is a facility located in a school building or on school grounds in this State that provides comprehensive primary health care services.
12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22	2. Coverage. A carrier offering a health plan in this State may not deny coverage on the basis that the coverage is delivered in a school-based health center operating under a contract with a federally qualified health center if the health care service would be covered if it were provided in the federally qualified health center. Coverage for health care services provided in a school-based health center must be determined in a manner consistent with coverage for health care services provided in a federally qualified health center. A carrier may offer a health plan containing a provision for a deductible, copayment or coinsurance requirement for a health care service provided in a school- based health center as long as the deductible, copayment or coinsurance does not exceed the deductible, copayment or coinsurance applicable to services provided in a federally qualified health center.

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## SUMMARY

This bill prohibits health insurance carriers from denying coverage for services delivered in a school setting under a contract with a federally qualified health center if the same services would be covered if provided at the federally qualified health center.
