Pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 3174-FF, subsection 3, paragraph C-1, these rules are major substantive rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A and must be provisionally adopted by the department and submitted to the Legislature no later than January 1, 2018.''

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$2,965,050 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$2,965,882 in fiscal year 2018-19, reduces some of the eligibility criteria in the bill related to Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 17, Allowances for Community Support Services and requires DHHS to fund the bill's remaining added services within existing budgeted resources. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also removed.
