SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 586, L.D. 837

Commissioner of Health and Human Services in consultation with the State Budget Officer, may transfer up to \$23,540,000 from the unexpended balance of the Fund for a Healthy Maine to the MaineCare Expansion Fund established in section 1 for the amount of medical costs of the MaineCare program that, as a result of expansion of the MaineCare program pursuant to Title 22, section 3174-G, subsection 1, paragraph H, will within the 15 days following the request exceed the sum of the total amount available in the Department of Health and Human Services, Medical Care - Payments to Providers program plus the total amount transferred pursuant to section 2. The commissioner shall submit copies of the written request submitted to the Governor to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs. The State Controller shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs any transfers made pursuant to this section.'

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Establishes the MaineCare Expansion Fund within the Department of Health and
 Human Services to provide the funds estimated to be necessary for expanded coverage
 under the MaineCare program required by Initiated Bill 2017, chapter 1, "An Act To
 Enhance Access to Affordable Health Care";

23 2. Limits the use of the fund to funding needed for the implementation and

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment transfers \$31,159,210 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the newly established MaineCare Expansion Fund for MaineCare services and payments to providers. Any unused balance in the fund as of June 30, 2019 will lapse back to the General Fund. This amendment also authorizes transfers from the Fund for a Healthy Maine up to \$23,540,000 for the same purposes in the event of a shortfall due to the expansion of eligibility for MaineCare.
