COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 599, L.D. 850, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit a Person from Providing False Testimony to a Committee of the Legislature"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §491 in subsection 1 in paragraph B by inserting after subparagraph (3) the following:

'(4) Member of the Legislature.'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §491 in subsection 1 in paragraph B by renumbering the subparagraphs to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is a minority report of the committee. The amendment adds members of the Legislature to the definition of "person," making Legislators subject to the provisions of the bill.
