Amend the bill in section 1 in §1778 in subsection 5 in paragraph A in the first line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "iron" the following: ', cement'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1778 in subsection 5 in paragraph B in the first line (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "iron" the following: ', cement'


Amend the bill in section 1 in §1779 in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 2, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "iron" the following: ', cement'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1779 in subsection 4 in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 3, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "iron" the following: ', cement'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1779 in subsection 4 in paragraph B in the first line (page 3, line 23 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "iron" the following: ', cement'

This amendment includes cement used in the construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair, improvement or maintenance of a public building or public work as a good that must be manufactured in the United States.
