1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §709** is enacted to read:

3 **§709. Use of state resources**

4 For any transportation project under this Title financed by a bond, the department
5 shall use to the extent practicable state employees and resources to perform the planning,
6 designing and engineering required for the project.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill requires the Department of Transportation to use to the extent practicable
9 state employees and resources to perform the planning, designing and engineering
10 required for transportation projects financed by bonding.
