11 12	Amend the bill in section 2 in §793 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph E (page 1, lines 30 to 35 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

Budget Advisory committee members serve 3-year terms except, in 1990, one member from each district must be elected for a one year term, one for a 2 year term and one for a 3-year term. If a budget an advisory committee member ceases to be a municipal officer during the term of membership, the committee member vacate membership and the next district caucus governing body of the vacating member's municipality shall elect a qualified municipal officer to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.'
20 21 22 23	Amend the bill in section 2 in §793 in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "committee." the following: 'The legislative member is a nonvoting member, except that the legislative member has a right to vote in the event of a tie vote of the advisory committee voting members.'
24 25 26	Amend the bill in section 3 in §795 in the next to the last line (page 2, line 16 in L.D. by striking out the following: "members present" and inserting the following 'membership'

28 29	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The amendment makes the following changes to the bill.
30 31	1. It provides for 3-year terms of the advisory committee voting members, instead o one-year terms as proposed in the bill.
32	2. It makes the legislative member a nonvoting member, except in the case of a ti
