1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2057, sub-§1,</b> ¶ <b>C,</b> as repealed and replaced by PL 2003, c. 452, Pt. Q, §36 and affected by Pt. X, §2, is amended to read:
4	C. A red light, if steady and circular, means:
5 6	(1) The operator must stop and remain stationary until an indication to proceed is shown; $\frac{\partial}{\partial x}$
7 8	(2) The operator may cautiously enter the intersection to make a right turn after stopping if:
9 10	(a) Not prohibited by an appropriate sign such as "NO RIGHT TURN ON RED" or "NO TURN ON RED"; and
11 12	(b) The operator executing a turn yields the right-of-way to pedestrians on a crosswalk and to a vehicle having a green signal at the intersection-; or
13 14	(3) The operator may cautiously enter the intersection to make a left turn after stopping if:
15 16	(a) Not prohibited by an appropriate sign such as "NO LEFT TURN ON RED" or "NO TURN ON RED"; and
17 18	(b) The operator executing a turn yields the right-of-way to pedestrians on a crosswalk and to a vehicle having a green signal at the intersection.
19 20	<b>Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2057, sub-§2,</b> as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
21 22 23	<b>2. Basis for prohibiting turn.</b> A municipality or the Department of Transportation, in determining whether to prohibit a right turn <u>or a left turn</u> on a red light, must consider at least the following factors:
24 25	A. The proximity to that light of schools, fire stations, residences or institutions for the blind;
26	B. The number of pedestrians using the intersection; and
27	C. The complexity of the intersection.
28	SUMMARY
29 30 31 32	This bill allows a motor vehicle operator to make a left turn at a red light after stopping if not prohibited by a sign such as "NO LEFT TURN ON RED" or "NO TURN ON RED" and the operator yields the right-of-way to pedestrians on a crosswalk and to a vehicle having a green signal at the intersection.
