
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 329,  
L.D. 990, Bill, "An Act To Protect Law Enforcement Officers by Creating the Crime of  
Aggravated Assault on an Officer"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §752-A in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the  
first line (page 1, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "intentionally,  
knowingly or recklessly" and inserting the following: 'intentionally, or knowingly ~~or~~  
~~recklessly~~'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §752-A in subsection 1 in paragraph D in the  
first line (page 1, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "intentionally,  
knowingly or recklessly" and inserting the following: 'intentionally or knowingly'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the mental state of recklessly from the crime of assault on  
an officer, leaving "intentionally" and "knowingly."
