COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 721, L.D. 1019, Bill, "An Act To Exempt Holders of Bear Hunting Permits from Archery Hunting License Requirements"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Establish a 6-day Nonresident Archery License'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11109, sub-§7, as amended by PL 2015, c. 245, §3, is further amended to read:

7. Archery hunting licenses; combination licenses; fees. Archery hunting licenses, combination licenses and fees are as follows:

A. A resident archery license is \$26;

B. A resident combination archery hunting and fishing license is \$43;

C. A nonresident archery license is \$75; ~~and~~

D. An alien archery license is \$85; ~~and~~

E. A nonresident 6-day archery license, which is valid for 6 consecutive hunting days, is \$26.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. The bill exempts a person over 16 years of age from the archery hunting license requirements when the person is hunting for bear under a valid bear hunting permit. The amendment establishes a 6-day nonresident archery license that costs \$26.

This bill establishes a 6-day nonresident archery license with a fee of \$26. The revenue impact to the General Fund is dependent upon the extent that nonresident hunters choose the \$26 6-day nonresident archery license instead of the \$75 annual nonresident archery license.
