COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 345, L.D. 1043, Bill, "An Act To Promote Impartiality in the Probate Court"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §309 in the indented paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 4 and 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Beginning January 1, 2021, a judge of probate may not practice law in the State while serving as a judge of probate."

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes from the bill the prohibition on probate judges engaging in the practice of law while serving as probate judges.
