This section does not prohibit an order, ordinance, rule or regulation of any political subdivision that regulates 14 possession of a firearm while inside an emergency medical services vehicle that is owned 15 or operated by or on behalf of the political subdivision. 16 SUMMARY 17 18 This amendment is one of 2 minority reports from the committee. The amendment 19 does not prohibit a political subdivision of the State from adopting an order, ordinance, 20 rule or regulation that regulates possession of a firearm while inside an emergency 21 medical services vehicle that is owned or operated by or on behalf of the political 22. subdivision.
