COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 733, L.D. 1050, Bill, "An Act To Protect the Safety of Emergency Medical Services Personnel and Patients"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2011, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:

3-A. Exception for emergency medical services vehicle. This section does not prohibit an order, ordinance, rule or regulation of any political subdivision requiring that a firearm carried inside an emergency medical services vehicle that is owned or operated by or on behalf of the political subdivision be locked in a lockbox by emergency medical services personnel.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is one of 2 minority reports from the committee. The amendment does not prohibit a political subdivision of the State from adopting an order, ordinance, rule or regulation requiring that a firearm carried inside an emergency medical services vehicle that is owned or operated by or on behalf of the political subdivision be locked in a lockbox by emergency medical services personnel.
