'Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the Legislative Council shall provide staff support to the commission, except that the Legislative Council staff support is not authorized when the Legislature is in regular or special session. The Legislative Council shall contract for necessary staff support for the commission during the legislative session and may contract for such staff support for a longer period to the extent needed and if sufficient funding is available; and be it further'
