18	SUMMARY
19	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, strikes the provisions
20	in the bill that define "caucus political action committee" and the provision that requires
21	each appointed legislative leader of a political party in the House of Representatives and
22	the Senate to designate one caucus political action committee to promote the election of
23 24	nominees to be the party's appointed leader. The amendment also strikes the provision in the bill that directs the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices to
24 25	submit an annual statistical report of campaign finance activity.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Any additional costs to the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices as a result of modifications to the definitions of elections, campaign contributions, campaign reports and campaign finance reporting deadlines are expected to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.

Any additional revenue to the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices as a result of the increase in the potential penalty from \$10 to \$100 for failure to register as a candidate or as a political committee is not anticipated to be significant.
