This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, replaces the bill and changes the title. It provides that a new motor vehicle that has had an inspection is not required to have another inspection until 2 years from the last day of the month in which it was initially registered. The amendment also provides that the inspection sticker fee for the one-time 2-year inspection of a new motor vehicle is \$7. After this time period has passed, the motor vehicle is required to have an annual motor vehicle safety inspection.

The bill provides that a new motor vehicle that has had an inspection does not need another inspection for two years. It also increases the cost of the inspection stickers for new motor vehicles from \$3.50 to \$7.00. There is no net increase or decrease to Highway Fund revenue.
