Amend the bill by adding after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.



#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment makes adjustments to Highway Fund and Other Special Revenue Funds allocations to reverse the effects of two initiatives that were inadvertently included in Part A of the Highway Fund Budget, LD 1440, now chaptered as PL 2017, c. 283. This amendment deallocates Highway Fund allocations to the Department of Secretary of State of \$51,059 annually beginning in fiscal year 2017-18. It also adds back Other Special Revenue Funds allocations to the Department of Transportation of \$1,000,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 2017-18.
