Federal grant funds received under Title I, Part A of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, 20 United States Code, Section 6301 et seq., as amended by the federal Every Student Succeeds Act, 20 United States Code, Chapter 70, must be used by a school administrative unit as defined by section 1, subsection 26 to:

28 29 30 31 32 33	This bill amends the school funding formula in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act to remove the reduction of the federal Title I funds under the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 received by school administrative units for teachers and other school staff and to require that school administrative units use federal Title I, Part A grant funds received under the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the federal Every Student Succeeds Act, only to
