4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to establish an alternative method for an employee to pay back an
6 employer for overcompensation of the employee due to the employer's error that is less of
7 a hardship on the employee than the present requirements of law, which allow an
8 employer to deduct up to 10% of an employee's wages to pay back the overcompensation
9 of the employee.
