COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 936, L.D. 1346, Bill, "An Act To Clarify Access to Landlocked Ancient and Family Burying Grounds and To Clarify the Definition of Ancient Burying Ground"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1-A in the 2nd paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd to last lines (page 2, lines 7 and 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "municipal clerk of the municipality" and inserting the following: 'registry of deeds in the county'

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1-A in the last paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "municipal clerk of the municipality" and inserting the following: 'registry of deeds in the county'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The amendment requires owners of land surrounding ancient or family burying grounds to file a notarized listing of obstructions with the county registry of deeds rather than the municipal clerk as in the bill.
