Fiscal Detail and Notes

Allowing public employees, including state, municipal, county, university, academy and community college employees, to strike if certain procedures are followed may result in increased bargaining and other direct and indirect costs. The impact will depend on the number and duration of strikes over time and cannot be determined at this time.
