The amendment specifies 21 that the crime of falsifying health care records applies if a person intends to deceive a 22 governmental entity, as well as another person. The amendment removes veterinary 23 hospitals from the definition of "health care provider." The amendment requires that the 24 type of bodily injury that is required to elevate the crime to Class C is serious bodily 25 injury.
