COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 969, L.D. 1395, "Resolve, To Name the Bridge over the Androscoggin River between the Towns of Peru and Mexico the Buddy Wendall McLain Bridge"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'Resolve, To Name the Bridge over the Androscoggin River between the Towns of Peru and Mexico the PFC Buddy Wendall McLain Memorial Bridge'**

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 1 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Route 191 bridge" and inserting the following: 'Bridge in the towns of Peru and Mexico'

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Buddy Wendall McLain Bridge" and inserting the following: 'PFC Buddy Wendall McLain Memorial Bridge'

This amendment designates Bridge 2019, which crosses the Androscoggin River between the Town of Peru and the Town of Mexico, the PFC Buddy Wendall McLain Memorial Bridge.
