1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §4320-K is enacted to read:
3	§4320-K. Coverage for diagnosis and treatment of Lyme disease
4 5 6	A carrier offering or renewing a health plan in this State shall provide coverage for the diagnosis and short-term and long-term treatment of Lyme disease. An increase in enrollee cost sharing to achieve compliance with this section may not be implemented.

8 9	This bill requires a carrier offering or renewing a health plan in the State to provide coverage to diagnose and treat Lyme disease.
