COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 980, L.D. 1422, Bill, "An Act To Require Presidential and Vice-Presidential Candidates To Disclose Their Federal Income Tax Returns"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §441 in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting the following: '3'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §441 in subsection 2 in the 5th line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting the following: '3'

Amend the bill in section 2 in the first paragraph in the next to last line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting the following: '3'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that a candidate for President or Vice President must disclose the previous 3 years of tax returns to appear on the general election ballot; the bill requires tax returns from the previous 5 years.
