Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph F in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "An" and inserting the following: 'If the costs exceed \$20, an'

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. It allows an agency or official to require payment of all costs before providing the requested public record only if the costs exceed \$20.
