21	As used in this article, unless the context otherwise indicates, "hydraulic fracturing"
22	means a stimulation technique used to increase production of oil and gas involving the
23 24	injection of fluids under pressures great enough to fracture the oil-producing and gas-producing rock formations.
25	<u>§490-XX. Prohibition on hydraulic fracturing</u>
26 27	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person may not perform or cause to be performed hydraulic fracturing in the State.
28	§490-YY. Prohibition on importation of wastes from hydraulic fracturing
29	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person may not
30	transport any hydraulic fracturing wastewater, waste product or by-product resulting from

3	SUMMARY
4 5 6 7 8	This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, changes the title, removes the emergency preamble and clause and replaces the bill. It prohibits hydraulic fracturing in the State and prohibits the transportation of hydraulic fracturing wastewater, waste products or by-products into the State for the purpose of treatment, discharge, disposal or storage.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill would prohibit hydraulic fracturing and the transportation of hydraulic fracturing by-products, wastewater and waste products in the State. The Department of Environmental Protection has indicated that current statutes regarding well injection, discharge of pollutants and groundwater protection regulations would all have the cumulative effect of preventing the granting of a permit to perform hydraulic fracturing activities in the State. Any additional costs to the department to coordinate the enforcement of the currently existing statutes with regard to hydraulic fracturing are anticipated to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
