COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1031, L.D. 1498, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Applicability of the Records Preservation Surcharge within County Registries of Deeds"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the next to the last line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "including quasi-independent agencies."

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Government" the following: 'including quasi-independent state entities as defined in Title 5, section 12021, subsection 5.'

This amendment provides a clarifying cross-reference to the definition of "quasi-independent state entity."
