1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §959, sub-§1, ¶P**, as amended by PL 2013, c. 505, §1, is further
3 amended to read:

4 P. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over utilities
5 and energy matters shall use the following list as a guideline for scheduling reviews:

6 (1) Public Advocate in ~~2015~~ 2019;

7 (2) Board of Directors, Maine Municipal and Rural Electrification Cooperative
8 Agency in 2015;

9 (3) Public Utilities Commission, including the Emergency Services
10 Communication Bureau, in ~~2015~~ 2021; and

11 (5) Telecommunications Relay Services Advisory Council in ~~2015~~ 2017.

12 **SUMMARY**

13 This bill is reported out by the Joint Standing Committee on Energy, Utilities and
14 Technology pursuant to a joint order. This bill changes the review schedule under the
15 State Government Evaluation Act for the Public Advocate, the Public Utilities
16 Commission and the Telecommunications Relay Services Advisory Council.
