(a) Had 10 years of creditable service on July 1, 1993, the segment amount must be reduced in the manner provided in section 17852, subsection 3, paragraphs A and B for each year that the member's age precedes 55 years of age; or

(b) Had fewer than 10 years of creditable service on July 1, 1993, the segment amount must be reduced by 6% for each year that the member's age precedes 55 years of age.

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Sec. 4. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§4, ¶F is enacted to read:

9F. The service retirement benefit of a member to whom subsection 1, paragraph M10applies and who qualifies for service retirement benefits under subsection 2 must be11computed under section 17852, subsection 1, paragraph A on the basis of all of the12member's creditable service in the capacity specified in subsection 1, paragraph M,13regardless of when that creditable service was earned, except that for a member14qualifying under subsection 2, paragraph B:

- 15(1) If the member had 10 years of service on July 1, 1993, the benefit must be16reduced as provided in section 17852, subsection 3, paragraphs A and B for each17year the member's age precedes 55 years of age; or
- 18 (2) If the member had fewer than 10 years of creditable service on July 1, 1993,
 19 the benefit must be reduced by 6% for each year that the member's age precedes
 20 55 years of age.

21 Sec. 5. Application. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 22 17851-A, subsection 1, paragraph M, that section of this Act that enacts Title 5, section 23 17851-A, subsection 4, paragraph F applies only to those Capitol Police officers in the 24 employment of the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Capitol Police as of the 25 effective date of this Act.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$40,610 in fiscal year 2018-19 to the Retirement System - Retirement Allowance Fund for the cost associated with allowing the service retirement benefits of one Capitol Police officer earned under the regular state employee and teacher plan to be calculated under the 1998 Special Plan. The cost of this provision is estimated based on the payment being made to the MainePERS by September 30, 2018.
