SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 619,
L.D. 1683, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Registered Maine Guide Background Check
Requirement"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the
following:

'An Act To Extend the Term of Guide Licenses'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines
16 to 28 in amendment).

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1 and 2.

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 5 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2019.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency clause.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter
or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision in Committee Amendment "A" that
establishes a Class E crime for failing to notify the Department of Inland Fisheries and
Wildlife of a conviction or a finding of not criminally responsible that is grounds for the
revocation, suspension or denial of a guide license within 30 days of the conviction or
finding. It retains the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" that extend the term of
and increase the fee for a guide license. It also removes the emergency preamble and
clause.
