COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1190, L.D. 1710, Bill, "An Act To Restore Maine's School-based Health Centers"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:

Sec. 1. Ongoing funding. During the First Regular Session of the 129th Legislature, the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters may report out legislation to provide ongoing funding for school-based health centers.'

Amend the bill in section 1 in the initiative in the first line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Restores funding" the following: 'on a one-time basis'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that funding for school-based health centers is a one-time appropriation from the Fund for a Healthy Maine and authorizes the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters to report out legislation to provide ongoing funding for school-based health centers in the First Regular Session of the 129th Legislature.

The bill includes Fund for a Healthy Maine allocations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$600,000 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$600,000 in fiscal year 2018-19 to restore funding on a one-time basis to the State's school-based health centers to the level of funding provided in fiscal year 2016-17.
