COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1205, L.D. 1725, Bill, "An Act To Ensure Stability for Certain Holders of Liquor Licenses"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-B in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "June 1, 2017" and inserting the following: 'January 1, 2018'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-B in the 3rd line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "June 1, 2017" and inserting the following: 'January 1, 2018'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-B in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "June 1, 2017" and inserting the following: 'the license was issued'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-B in paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "prior to June 1, 2017"

SUMMARY

The bill establishes June 1, 2017 as the date before which certain liquor licensees must have been issued a license to be subject to the grandfathering provision in the bill. This amendment changes that date to January 1, 2018.
